<b>Asset Class</b>	<b>Performance Measures</b>	<b>Target</b>
<b>Rolling Stock</b> All revenue vehicles	<b>Age</b> - % of revenue vehicles within a particular asset class that have met or exceeded their Useful Life Benchmark (ULB)	<b>10% of buses and vans must exceed ULB</b>
<b>Equipment</b> Non-revenue vehicles	<b>Age</b> - % of vehicles that have met or exceeded their Useful Life Benchmark (ULB)	<b>0.9</b>
<b>Facilities</b> All building or structures	<b>Condition</b> - % of facilities with a condition rating below 3.0 on the FTA Transit Economic Requirements Model (TERM) Scale	<b>All building must remain above 3.0 rating on the TERM scale</b>
