***Rapides Parish Police Jury Code of Ordinances,
Chapter 22, Article 3, Sec.22-140. Special procedures.***

Revocations of dedicated rights-of-way and/or servitudes by a public body shall be considered only after a report concerning the revocation is issued in writing by the staff and/or subdivision technical review committee of the Rapides Area Planning Commission, and the engineer representing the local government (Ord. of 7-18-78; Ord. of 5-12-03)

REVOCATION PROCESS:

- 1. All applications should be submitted to the Rapides Area Planning Commission no later than the last working day of the month in order to be reviewed in the following month.**
- 2. The application must be completed and three copies attached.
(One copy for RAPC, RPPJ Secretary, RPPJ Engineer)**
- 3. The review fee (\$100.00) must be attached at time application is submitted.**
- 4. The Rapides Parish Police Jury will place the revocation on their next agenda and a thirty (30) day review period will be designated.**
- 5. The staff will review the application and issue a written recommendation at the conclusion of the thirty day lay over period.**
- 6. It is the responsibility of the applicant to file all necessary documentation with the Clerk of Courts office.**
